Statement of notification to correct cartographical errors within the Scarcroft Neighbourhood Plan in advance of the Scarcroft Neighbourhood Plan Referendum, Thursday 14th February 2019

In accordance with Regulation 5(3)(b) of the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendums) Regulations 2012 this Notice is published in order to correct inaccurate information in the Referendum draft Scarcroft Neighbourhood Plan, publicised for Referendum.

The Council has a responsibility to correct inaccuracies in connection with the Plan, which will be subject to a Referendum on Thursday 14th February 2019 at Scarcroft Village Hall, Wetherby Road, Scarcroft, LS14 3AS, 7.00AM-10.00 PM.

With the consent of Scarcroft Parish Council as the Qualifying Body, Leeds City Council is publishing notification of a non-material amendment to the Scarcroft Neighbourhood Plan Policies Map (page 29 of the Referendum draft Scarcroft Neighbourhood Plan). The cartographical errors are as follows:

- Incorrect boundary of the Unitary Development Plan Policy N37 Special Landscape Area; and
- Incorrect route of Roman Road 72b.

The corrections to address the cartographical errors are provided in the map appended to this Notice. The corrections have no material impact on the neighbourhood plan.
